



Planning application for new Staploe Medical Centre has been submitted.

6th February 2024

Further to our <u>pre-announcement</u> in December, we are delighted to announce that a full, detailed planning application for a new Staploe Medical Centre has now been submitted.

We believe that this application is essential to enable us to continue providing service to our patients, as well as keep up with housing developments in Soham, Fordham, Isleham, Chippenham, Wicken, and the other surrounding villages that we serve.

This is a joint application between Mereside Medical and This Land. The reason for this is that the application spans land owned by Mereside Medical (the current site) and This Land (the proposed new site, within the Soham Eastern Gateway housing development, Planning Ref: 19/01600/ESO).

After exploring many options, the location indicated in the Soham Eastern Gateway is the *only* location in Soham that is central enough *and* large enough to deliver a building fit for the future.

We know that many of you may have questions about what we are proposing, so we have prepared a Frequently Asked Questions document, available at www.meresidemedical.nhs.uk/about/staploe-new-build. You should soon be able to see the proposal on the East Cambridgeshire District Council planning portal: https://pa.eastcambs.gov.uk/online-applications/. If you live within the immediate vicinity of the site, you should also receive a letter about this inviting your views. There will also be a Site Notice on display in the vicinity.

It is really important to us that we offer our registered patients the opportunity to come and see the proposed designs and ask questions in person, in, or close to, their home village.

We have therefore organised a series of events across the Staploe Medical Centre catchment area, covering as many locations and times of day as possible. If you are unable to join us at one of these events, please visit the practice after 19th Feb to see the display boards showing the designs.
